**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act providing for the appointment and length of terms for  
2 members added to a hospital board of trustees.

1 Section 1. Section 392.6, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code  
2 Supplement 1999, is amended to read as follows:  
3 Cities maintaining an institution as provided for in this  
4 section which have a board of trustees consisting of three or  
5 five members may by ordinance increase the number of members  
6 to five or seven and. The ordinance shall provide for the  
7 appointment of one additional member in the expansion of a  
8 three-member board to a five-member board or in the expansion  
9 of a five-member board to a seven-member board, or for the  
10 appointment of two additional members in the expansion of a  
11 three-member board to a seven-member board until the next  
12 succeeding general or city election, and for the appointment  
13 of the one or two other additional members until the second  
14 succeeding general or city election. Thereafter, the terms of  
15 office of such additional members shall be four years.  
16 However, if a city has adopted an ordinance which increases  
17 the number of members of the board of trustees to five or  
18 seven members and the terms of office of four of the five  
19 members or six of the seven members end in the same year, the  
20 date of expiration of the term of one of the four members or  
21 two of the six members, to be determined by lot, shall be  
22 extended by an additional two years.

23 EXPLANATION

24 This bill provides that when the number of hospital board  
25 of trustees increases from three to five members, or from five  
26 to seven members, one of the two additional members shall  
27 serve until the next succeeding general or city election. The  
28 other additional member serves until the second succeeding  
29 election. If the board expands from three members to seven,  
30 then two additional members will serve until the next  
31 election. Under current law, expansion to seven members from  
32 a five-member board requires that two of the additional  
33 members serve until the next succeeding election, preventing  
34 the staggering of terms as provided for other expansions.

22 of the board of trustees to five or seven members and the  
23 terms of office of four of the five members or six of the  
24 seven members end in the same year, the date of expiration of  
25 the term of one of the four members or two of the six members,  
26 to be determined by lot, shall be extended by an additional  
27 two years.

28 EXPLANATION

29 This bill provides that when the number of hospital board  
30 of trustees increases from three to five members, or from five  
31 to seven members, the two additional members shall be  
32 appointed immediately and one of the two additional members  
33 shall serve until the next succeeding general or city  
34 election. The other additional member serves until the second  
35 succeeding election. If the board expands from three members

1 to seven, the four additional members will be appointed  
2 immediately and two of the additional members will serve until  
3 the next election with the remaining two additional members  
4 serving until the second succeeding election. The  
5 determination of the differing length of appointed terms for  
6 additional members is to be made by lot.

AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT AND LENGTH OF TERMS FOR MEMBERS  
ADDED TO A HOSPITAL BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 392.6, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code Supplement 1999, is amended to read as follows:

Cities maintaining an institution as provided for in this section which have a board of trustees consisting of three or five members may by ordinance increase the number of members to five or seven and. The ordinance shall provide for the immediate appointment of one-additional-member-in-the expansion-to-a-five-member-board-or-two-additional-members-in-the-expansion-to-a-seven-member-board the additional members necessary to establish a five-member or seven-member board and shall provide that, of the additional members added to the board by appointment, one-half of the additional members added shall serve until the next succeeding general or city election, and for-the-appointment-of-the-one-or-two-other the remaining additional members shall serve until the second succeeding general or city election. The ordinance shall also provide that the determination of which election an appointed additional member shall be required to seek election be determined by lot. Thereafter, the terms of office of such additional members shall be four years. However, if a city has adopted an ordinance which increases the number of members of the board of trustees to five or seven members and the terms of office of four of the five members or six of the

seven members end in the same year, the date of expiration of the term of one of the four members or two of the six members, to be determined by lot, shall be extended by an additional two years.
