21 disseminate information and provide instruction regarding
22 subjects relating to agriculture, home economics, and
23 community and economic development. Code section 176A.8
24 provides that the council is responsible for managing the
25 business affairs of its district. It also provides that the
26 council may manage a county agricultural extension education
27 fund for a variety of purposes. The bill removes a limitation
28 that prohibits the council from using moneys in the fund to
29 lease office space which is occupied or used by a farm
30 organization or farm cooperative or to lease space in a
31 building owned or occupied by a farm organization or farm
32 cooperative.
