APPROPRIATIONS

1 Section 1. DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION. There is appropriated  
2 from the general fund of the state to the department of  
3 education for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and  
4 ending June 30, 2001, the following amount, or so much thereof  
5 as is necessary, to be used for the purpose designated:

6 For the beginning teacher induction program as provided in  
7 section 256E.2:

8 ..... \$ 600,000

9 Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys appropriated in this  
10 section that remain unencumbered or unobligated at the close  
11 of the fiscal year shall not revert but shall remain available  
12 for expenditure for the purposes designated until the close of  
13 the succeeding fiscal year.

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill appropriates moneys from the general fund of the  
16 state to the department of education for the beginning teacher  
17 induction program for fiscal year 2000-2001. Any moneys  
18 remaining from the amount appropriated carry over to the  
19 succeeding fiscal year for the purposes designated in this  
20 bill.
