A BILL FOR

1 An Act providing for access to the Iowa communications network by
2 homeland security or defense facilities.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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1 Section 1. Section 8D.2, subsection 5, Code Supplement
2 2001, is amended to read as follows:

3 5. "Public agency" means a state agency, an institution
4 under the control of the board of regents, the judicial branch
5 as provided in section 8D.13, subsection 17, a school
6 corporation, a city library, a library service area as
7 provided in chapter 256, a county library as provided in
8 chapter 336, or a judicial district department of correctional
9 services established in section 905.2, to the extent provided
10 in section 8D.13, subsection 15, an agency of the federal
11 government, or a United States post office which receives a
12 federal grant for pilot and demonstration projects. For the
13 purposes of this chapter, a public agency shall include any
14 homeland security or defense facility established by the
15 administrator of the emergency management division of the
16 department of public defense, or the governor, or any facility
17 connected with a security or defense system as required by the
18 administrator of the emergency management division of the
19 department of public defense, or the governor.

20 EXPLANATION

21 This bill provides that a homeland security or defense
22 facility established by the administrator of the emergency
23 management division of the department of public defense, or
24 the governor, shall be regarded as a public agency for
25 purposes of access to the Iowa communications network.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 8D.2, subsection 5, Code Supplement 2001, is amended to read as follows:

5. a. "Public agency" means a state agency, an institution under the control of the board of regents, the judicial branch as provided in section 8D.13, subsection 17, a school corporation, a city library, a library service area as provided in chapter 256, a county library as provided in chapter 336, or a judicial district department of correctional services established in section 905.2, to the extent provided in section 8D.13, subsection 15, an agency of the federal government, or a United States post office which receives a federal grant for pilot and demonstration projects.

b. For the purposes of this chapter, "public agency" also includes any homeland security or defense facility established by the administrator of the emergency management division of the department of public defense or the governor or any facility connected with a security or defense system as required by the administrator of the emergency management division of the department of public defense or the governor. A facility that is considered a public agency pursuant to this paragraph shall be authorized to access the Iowa communications network strictly for homeland security communication purposes.
