Introduction

Imagine you are an attorney whose firm handled a matter for a now disgruntled former client who is upset about the outcome. This man finds you on social media and berates you with both private and public messages. He then comes to your place of work to picket your firm with a sign disparaging your character and the reputation of your firm. He, a man that has made you and your firm aware of his tendency to carry a concealed weapon, finds you in public at an event whose location was not publicly disclosed and whose attendees include close friends and family. This is the story of West Virginia Attorney Teresa Toriseva[], but it could happen to anyone. Without the person in question being arrested for harassment or stalking, there is currently no path for an Iowa attorney to have a court intervene for protection.
