

SF2067 Page 1, Section 1, lines 4 and 5 DEFINE reasonably available. Define diligently exhausted.

Line 11 Supporting agriculture in the state of Iowa recognizes that family farms ARE businesses, and are a primary drive of the economic wellbeing of the State of Iowa. As such, family farms and individual landowners SHALL be protected from the use of eminent domain to seize their property by any person to acquire right-of-way for, construct, or operate a pipeline for the primary purpose of transporting carbon oxide.

Line 13 The Iowa Legislature, Governor, and Iowa Utilities Board SHALL recognize that family farmers invest in Iowa agriculture every day through their purchase of land, of their purchase of equipment manufactured in Iowa, of chemicals purchased from Iowa businesses, by employing persons living within the state, and by financing agricultural research and development through corn checkoff promotions, as well as by other means. Furthermore, the Iowa Legislature, Governor, and Iowa Utilities Board SHALL recognize that investment in the future of Iowa's agricultural sector depends upon the surety for new generations of Iowa farmers that their land SHALL NOT be taken from them by means of eminent domain.

As such, Senate File 2067 SHALL BE DEFEATED with a majority of NO votes.
