

The report required under subsection 2 shall include, at a minimum, all of the following:

- a. The number of voters who requested participation in the pilot program and the number who successfully participated.
- b. Success rates, including the percentage of ballots successfully marked independently by participants, and the rejection rates of returned ballots due to marking errors, technology failures, or other issues.
- c. Results from anonymous and accessible voter feedback or satisfaction surveys administered to participants, including any reported challenges with independence, privacy, or usability of the assistive technologies.
- d. The average cost per participant, any significant technology or implementation challenges encountered by participating counties or the state commissioner, any security incidents or concerns (if any), and a comparison of the pilot program's accessibility and effectiveness to in-person accessible voting options currently available under state law.
- e. Barriers encountered by voters or election officials during the pilot, and recommendations for improvements, expansion, or statewide implementation.
