Judicial Branch Proposed Amendment: SSB 1053

Amend section 5, subsection 1 as follows:

1. The court may exclude or redact from all pleadings and documents filed in the action other ildentifying characteristics of the plaintiff shall be redacted from all pleadings and documents filed in the action under rule of civil procedure 1.422, without court order.

Amend section 5, subsection 2 as follows:

2. A plaintiff to whom subsection 1 applies shall file with the court and serve on the defendant a <u>confidential protected information form, pursuant to rule of electronic procedure 16.606,</u> that includes the excluded or redacted plaintiff's name and other identifying characteristics.
