Chair Baltimore read the following bills for consideration:

HSB 15 - Hess CH, Lensing, Worthan
HSB 25 - Hess CH, Anderson, Baltimore
HSB 14 - Hess CH, Hagenow, Dawson

Chair Baltimore recognized Representative Hess for opening statements on Amendment 6 to HSB 15. The amendment passed by voice vote. HSB 15 was discussed and Representative Hess was recognized for closing comments and it passed with the unanimous vote of 21 - 0 (yes). Chair Baltimore announced the passing of HSB 15, receiving the majority, that it would pass the Floor of the House as a committee bill.

Chair Baltimore recognized Representative Hess for opening statements on HSB 25. With no further discussion or questions, the bill was passed with the unanimous consent of 21 - 0 (yes). Chair Baltimore announced the passing of HSB 25 to the Floor of the House as a committee bill.

Chair Baltimore recognized Representative Hess for the final Bill of consideration, HSB 14. Discussion was held and the vote was counted at 20 - 1 (yes) with Representative Heaton voting Nay. Chair Baltimore announced with the majority vote that HSB 14 be passed to the Floor of the House as a committee bill.
