Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Pettengill for opening comments on HSB 23, an act relating to proof of identification and proof of residence in order to register to vote or to vote, creating a criminal offense for falsely swearing certain oaths and affidavits, and including applicability provisions. Representative Pettengill introduced Amendment 459 to HSB 23. Following discussion, Amendment 459 was passed by voice vote.

The committee recessed at 4:00 pm and reconvened at 5:00 pm.

Following discussion, Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Pettengill for closing comments on HSB 23. Representative Pettengill moved HSB 23, as amended.
