On February 28th at 2:05 p.m., an immediate House Judiciary meeting was scheduled in Room 102 with the purpose of assigning and considering bills. The following bills were assigned:

The following bills were considered:

Chairperson Baltimore recognized Representative Kaufmann for opening comments on HF 219. He introduced Amendment 241 where it passed unanimously by voice vote. With no discussion of HF 219 as amended Representative Kaufmann delivered his closing comments and it was moved to a vote. HF 219 will be passed to House Floor as an individual bill as amended with the a vote of 19 (y) - 2(n). The naye's included Representative Dawson and M. Smith.

Chairperson Baltimore recognized Representative Kaufmann for opening comments regarding HSB 161. Amendment 412 to HSB 161 was introduced and it was passed by unanimous voice vote. With no discussion, Representative Kaufmann moved HSB 161 as amended to a vote. With the unanimous vote of 21 (y) - 0 (n), HSB 161 gained the constitutional majority and will be moved to the House Floor as a committee bill.

Chairperson Baltimore recognized Representative Hagenow for opening comments on HSB 143. There was no further discussion and it was immediately moved to a vote after closing comments. With 21 (y) - 0 (n), HSB 143 will be moved to the House Floor as a committee bill.

Lastly, Chairperson Baltimore recognized Representative Hess for opening comments on HF 104. Representative Hess introduced Amendment 330 where it was passed with a voice vote. HF 104 as amended received no further discussion and Representative Hess moved to a vote. With 21 (y) - 0 (n), HF 104 as amended will move to the House Floor as a committee bill.

With no further business, Chairperson Baltimore adjourned at 2:40 p.m.
