After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Dolecheck for closing comments on HF 140. Representative Dolecheck moved HF 140. The bill passed with a roll call vote of 23 ayes to 0 nays. Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Representative Byrnes for opening comments of HF 227 (An act providing for entrepreneurial education accounts for student organizations and clubs and including effective date and applicability provisions). Representative Byrnes noted that there was an amendment.

The Chair recognized Representative Steckman for opening comments on amendment HF 227.563. After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Steckman for closing comments on amendment HF 227.563. Representative Steckman moved the amendment. The amendment was adopted by a unanimous voice vote.
