The State Government Committee was called to order by Chair Vander Linden at 2:00 pm.

Roll Call was taken with a quorum present.

As there were no corrections, amendments, and/or deletions to the February 28th meeting minutes, Chair Vander Linden moved to approve the minutes as distributed.

The following bills were assigned to subcommittees:

Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Stanerson for opening comments on HJR 7, a joint resolution relating to the location and exhibition of the statue of James Harlan, currently on display in the United States Capitol. Representative Stanerson introduced Amendment 543 to HJR 7. Following discussion, Amendment 543 was passed by voice vote. Following discussion, Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Stanerson for closing comments on HJR 7, as amended. Representative Stanerson moved HJR 7. A record roll call was taken, and HJR 7 passed, as amended, moving the bill to the floor of the House as a committee bill, (21-0).

Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Koester for opening comments on HF 166, an act relating to persons offering orthotic, prosthetic, and pedorthic services to the public, and relating to the scope of orthotic, prosthetic, and pedorthic services which may be ordered by certain health care providers, and including transition provisions. Following discussion, Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Koester for closing comments on HF 166. Representative Koester moved HF 166. A record roll call was taken, and HF 166 passed, moving the bill to the floor of the House as a committee bill, (21-1) (Nay: Watts).
