Chair opened the floor to discussion on Amendment 682 (3). Stanerson moved the adoption of Amendment 682 (3), a record roll call was taken and passed with a unanimous voice vote.

With unanimous consent of the committee Representative Pettengill was able to ask questions of Dean Kaster on what was involved with a court case of the bill that is discussed. The discussion then went back to the committee members on Amendment 581.
