On March 7th, 2013 an immediate House Judiciary meeting was scheduled at 4:00 p.m., in Room 102 with the purpose of considering bills. Roll call was taken and all members were present with Representative Oldson being excused.

As there were no corrections, amendments and/or deletions to the March 6 meeting minutes, they were unanimously approved.

Chairperson Baltimore called the meeting to order and turned the meeting over to Representative Hess. Representative Hess then recognized Chairperson Baltimore for opening comments on HSB 172. Discussion was opened where a subcommittee was requested and opened to the committee as a whole. Chairperson Baltimore yielded to Representative Wolfe's questions. With no public input on subcommittee for HSB 172 it was moved back to the committee as a whole. With no further discussion on HSB 172, the vote was taken. With 19 (y) - 1 (n), HSB 172 received the constitutional majority and will be moved the House Floor as a committee bill. The naye was put forth by Representative Wolfe.

Representative Hess then returned the meeting back to Chairperson Baltimore.

Chairperson Baltimore recognized Representative Brandenburg for opening comments on HSB 193. Amendment 697 was passed with a voice vote. Discussion was opened for HSB 193 as amended. With no further discussion the bill was taken to a vote. HSB 193 as amended will be passed to the House Floor as a committee bill with a vote of 20 (y) - 0 (n).

Chairperson Baltimore recognized Representative Kaufmann for opening comments on HSB 142. There was no further comments on HSB 142 and a vote was taken. With 20 (y) - 0 (n), HSB 142 will be moved the House Floor as a committee bill.

Chairperson Baltimore recognized Representative Kaufmann for opening comments on HSB 173. Discussion was opened with comments from Representative Wessel-Kroeschell. With no further comments, HSB 173 was moved to a vote. With 12 (y) - 8 (n), HSB 172 will be moved to the House Floor as a committee bill. The naves included Representative Wolfe, Anderson, Dawson, Lensing, R. Olson, T. Olson, Smith, Wessel-Kroeschell.

Chairperson Baltimore turned the meeting over to Representative Hess.

Representative Hess introduced Chairperson Baltimore for opening comments on HSB 208. With no discussion the bill was moved to a vote. With 20 (y) - 0 (n), HSB 208 will be moved to the House Floor as a committee bill.

Representative Hess introduced Chairperson Baltimore for opening comments on HF 258. Amendment 647 was introduced by Chairperson Baltimore and it passed the committee by a voice vote. HSB 258 as amended received no further discussion and it was moved to a committee vote. With 20 (y) - 0 (n), HF 258 as amended will be moved to the House Floor as a committee bill.

Representative Hess introduced Chairperson Baltimore for opening comments on HSB 215. Discussion was opened and Representative Lensing began discussion. HSB 215 was brought to a vote and it will be passed to the House Floor as a committee bill with a vote of 15 (y) - 5 (n). The nays included Representative Wolfe, Anderson, Dawson, Smith, Wessel-Kroeschell.

Representative Hess recognized Chairperson Baltimore for opening comments on HSB 210. Amendment 650 was introduced and opening comments were given by Representative Smith. There was no further discussion regarding Amendment 650 and it was passed with a voice vote. Discussion was opened for HSB 210 as amended. With no further discussion the vote was taken. With 20 (y) - 0 (n), HSB 210 as amended will be moved to the House Floor as a committee bill.

Representative Hess then returned the meeting to Chairperson Baltimore.

Chairperson Baltimore recognized Representative Garrett for opening comments regarding HSB 104. Amendment 588 was introduced followed with opening comments from Representative Garrett. With no comment on Amendment 588, it was passed with a voice vote. HSB 104 as amended was opened for discussion starting with questions from Representative Heaton. Representative Garrett yielded to the questions. Representative Anderson and Chairperson Baltimore were also recognized during discussion of HSB 104 as amended. HSB 104 as amended was moved to a vote, it will be moved to the House Floor as a committee bill receiving the constitutional majority with 13 (y) - 7 (n). The nays included Wolfe, Anderson, Lensing, R. Olson, T. Olson, Smith, Wessel-Kroeschell.

Chairperson Baltimore recognized Representative Hess for opening comments on HF 109. Discussion was opened and Representative Wessel-Kroeschell and Representative Wolfe were recognized for comments. Representative Hess moved HF 109 and it will be moved to the House Floor as a committee bill receiving the constitutional majority with 12 (y) - 8 (n). The nays included Representative Wolfe, Anderson, Dawson, Lensing, R. Olson, T. Olson, Smith, Wessel-Kroeschell.

With no further business to come before the committee, Chairperson Baltimore adjourned at 5:35 p.m.
