The bill passed with a roll call vote of 22 ayes, 0 nays and 1 absent (Fry). Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor.

The Chair recognized Representative Hess for opening comments on SF 338 (An act requiring background checks for school employees). After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Hess for closing comments on SF 338. Representative Hess moved SF 338. The bill passed with a roll call vote of 22 ayes, 0 nays and 1 absent (Fry). Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor.

The Chair recognized Representative Koester for opening comments on SF 339 (An act relating to inspections of school buses and certain other vehicles used to transport children and making penalties applicable). Representative Koester noted that there were amendments.

The Chair recognized Representative Koester for opening comments on amendment SF 339.1220. After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Koester for closing comments on amendment SF 339.1220. Representative Koester moved his amendment. The amendment was adopted by a unanimous voice vote.

Having disposed of all amendments, the committee was back on consideration of SF 339 as amended. After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Koester for closing comments on SF 339 as amended. Representative Koester moved SF 339 as amended. The bill as amended passed with a roll call vote of 22 ayes, 0 nays and 1 absent (Fry). Having received a constitutional majority, the bill as amended will move to the floor.
