Representative Soderberg called the Appropriations Committee to order. The Chair dispensed with roll. Minutes from the March 26, 2013 meeting were approved.

The Chair assigned the following bills:

SF 296 A bill for an act relating to integrated care models for the delivery of health care, including but not limited to required utilization of a medical home by individuals currently and newly eligible for coverage under the Medicaid program and including effective date provisions. (Formerly [SF 71](#).)

SF 429 A bill for an act relating to workforce training programs and making appropriations. (Formerly [SF 291](#).)

HF 620 A bill for an act relating to the economic development financial assistance duties and powers of the economic development authority by authorizing and creating fees, affecting the aggregate tax credit limit for certain economic development programs and the tax credit for the endow Iowa tax credit, authorizing the diversion of withholding tax payments for certain programs, making an appropriation, and including effective date and retroactive applicability provisions. (Formerly [HF 584](#)) (Formerly [HSB 132](#))

Republicans and Democrats went to caucus at 11:42.

Representative Soderberg called the meeting back to order at 11:50.

Representative Soderberg recognized Representative Highfill for opening remarks on HF 502 a bill for an act relating to real estate broker and real estate salesperson licensing fees and allocations from those fees, and making an appropriation. (Formerly [HSB 164](#)) Discussion followed.

Representative Soderberg recognized Representative Highfill for opening remarks on

amendment 502.1385. Following discussion, Representative Highfill was recognized for closing comments and the amendment passed, short form.

The Chair recognized Representative Highfill for closing remarks, and Representative Highfill moved the bill. HF 502, as amended, passed, 23-0. Representatives voting yes: Soderberg, Lofgren, Deyoe, Drake, Fisher, Garrett, Heaton, Highfill, Huseman, Koester, Rogers, Watts, Worthan, Olson, Bearinger, Dunkel, Hall, Heddens, Kajtazovic, Lundby, Murphy, Taylor, and Winckler. Representatives Dolecheck and Running-Marquardt were absent and did not vote. With passage, HF 502, as amended, moves to the House floor as a committee bill.
