Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Hagenow for opening comments on [SF 396](#), an act relating to government operations and efficiency and other related matters, and including effective date and applicability provisions. Following discussion, Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Hagenow for closing comments on [SF 396](#). Representative Hagenow moved [SF 396](#). A record roll call was taken, and [SF 396](#) passed, moving the bill to the floor of the House as a senate file, (19-4) (Nays: Cohoon, Hunter, Mascher, Winckler).

The committee recessed at 2:55 pm and reconvened at 4:35 pm.

Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Stanerson for opening comments on [SF 380](#), an act authorizing charitable auctions for alcoholic spirits. Following discussion, Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Stanerson for closing comments on [SF 380](#). Representative Stanerson moved [SF 380](#). A record roll call was taken, and [SF 380](#) passed, moving the bill to

the floor of the House as a senate file, (20-1) (Nay: Costello).
