Representative Heaton opened discussion and the Amendment was moved to a voice vote. The Amendment passed and [SF 406](#) as amended was opened for discussion. With no further discussion Representative Baltimore moved [SF 406](#) as amended. With 11(y)-9(n) votes, [SF 406](#) as amended received the constitutional majority and will be moved the House Floor as a Senate File. Chairperson Baltimore recognized Representative Kaufmann for opening comments on [SF 343](#). There was no further discussion and [SF 343](#) was moved to a vote. With 20(y)-0(n) votes, [SF 343](#) received the constitutional majority and will be moved to the House Floor as a Senate File.
