With no additions or corrections to the previous meeting minutes, the minutes were approved as distributed.

Chair Byrnes recognized Representative Landon for opening comments on SF 114, an act relating to the filing of a certificate of deposit by the owner of a motor vehicle as proof of financial responsibility. Representative Landon moved SF 114, a record roll call was taken, and SF 114 passed moving the bill to the floor of the House as a Senate File. (21 ayes, 0 nays)

Chair Byrnes turned the meeting over to Vice-Chair Moore.

Vice-Chair Moore recognized Chair Byrnes for opening comments on SF 115, an act relating to intermediate driver's licenses and special minor's licenses, making a penalty applicable, and including effective date provisions. Chair Byrnes moved SF 115, a record roll call was taken, and SF 115 passed moving the bill to the floor of the House as a Senate File. (21 ayes, 0 nays)

Vice-Chair Moore turned the meeting over to Chair Byrnes.

Chair Byrnes recognized Representative Heartsill for opening comments on SF 340, an act relating to the length of on-duty periods and required rest periods for drivers of rail crew transport vehicles, and providing penalties. Representative Heartsill moved SF 340, a record roll call was taken, and SF 340 passed moving the bill to the floor of the House as a Senate File. (21 ayes, 0 nays)

Chair Byrnes recognized Representative Landon for opening comments on SF 364, an act concerning vehicle registration fees, including matters relating to evasion of fees and to fees for electric vehicles, providing penalties, and including applicability provisions. Representative Landon moved SF 364, a record roll call was taken, and SF 364 passed moving the bill to the floor of the House as a Senate File. (21 ayes, 0 nays)

Chair Byrnes thanked the committee for their hard work and bipartisan effort.
