Representative Soderberg called the Appropriations Committee to order. Roll was called; quorum present. Minutes from the April 4, 2013, meeting were approved.

The Chair assigned the following bill:

HSB 232 A study bill relating to establishing a healthy Iowa plan, and making appropriations.

SF 296 A bill for an act relating to integrated care models for the delivery of health care, including but not limited to required utilization of a medical home by individuals currently and newly eligible for coverage under the Medicaid program and including effective date provisions. (Formerly SF71">SF 71.)

SF 304 A bill for an act concerning public safety by establishing a public safety training and equipment trust fund, making appropriations to the fund, providing for a public safety training and facilities task force, and making appropriations. (Formerly SF 133.) Worthan, Chair; Garrett, Taylor

Republicans and Democrats went to caucus at 10:10 a.m. Representative Soderberg called the meeting back to order at 10:45 a.m.

Representative Soderberg recognized Representative Deyoe for opening remarks on <u>SF 430</u>, a bill for an act relating to appropriations to the department of cultural affairs, the economic development authority, the board of regents and certain board of regents institutions, the department of workforce development, the Iowa finance authority, and the public employment relations board, providing for other properly related matters, and including effective date and retroactive applicability provisions. (Formerly <u>SSB 1246</u>.)

Representative Soderberg recognized Representative Deyoe for opening remarks on amendment <u>SF 430</u>.1511. Following discussion, Representative Deyoe was recognized for closing

comments and moved the amendment, which passed, short form.

The Chair recognized Representative Deyoe for closing remarks on <u>SF 430</u>, as amended. Following discussion, Representative Deyoe moved the bill. <u>SF 430</u>, as amended, passed, 14-10. Representatives voting yes: Soderberg, Lofgren, Deyoe, Dolecheck, Drake, Fisher, Garrett, Heaton, Highfill, Huseman, Koester, Rogers, Watts, and Worthan. Representatives voting no: Olson, Bearinger, Dunkel, Hall, Heddens, Kajtazovic, Lundby, Murphy, Running-Marquardt, and Winckler. Representative Taylor was excused and did not vote. With passage, <u>SF 430</u>, as amended moves to the House floor as a Senate file.

Representative Soderberg recognized Representative Lofgren for opening remarks on HF 620, a bill for an act relating to the economic development financial assistance duties and powers of the economic development authority by authorizing and creating fees, affecting the aggregate tax credit limit for certain economic development programs and the tax credit for the endow Iowa tax credit, authorizing the diversion of withholding tax payments for certain programs, making an appropriation, and including effective date and retroactive applicability provisions. (Formerly HF 584) (Formerly HSB 132) Discussion followed.

The Chair recognized Representative Lofgren for closing remarks on HF 620 and Representative Lofgren moved the bill. HF 620 passed, 22-2. Representatives voting yes: Soderberg, Lofgren, Deyoe, Dolecheck, Drake, Fisher, Garrett, Heaton, Highfill, Huseman, Koester, Rogers, Watts, Worthan, Olson, Bearinger, Dunkel, Hall, Heddens, Kajtazovic, Lundby, and Running-Marquardt. Representatives voting no: Murphy and Winckler. Representative Taylor was excused and did not vote. With passage, HF 620 moves to the House floor as a Ways and Means bill.

With no further business to come before the committee, Representative Devoe moved to arise at 11:35.
