Representative Soderberg recognized Representative Worthan for opening remarks on amendment 442.1675 and amendment <u>SF 442</u>.1675.1695. Following discussion, Representative Worthan was recognized for closing comments and the amendment <u>SF 442</u>.1675.1695, passed, short form.

Discussion returned to <u>SF 442</u>, as amended. The Chair recognized Representative Worthan for closing remarks, and Representative Worthan moved the bill. <u>SF 442</u> passed as amended, 25-0. Representative Soderberg recognized Representative Highfill for opening remarks on amendment <u>HF 576</u>.1664. Following discussion, Representative Highfill was recognized for closing comments and the amendment <u>HF 576</u>.1664, passed, short form.

The Chair recognized Representative Highfill for closing remarks, and Representative Highfill
moved the bill. HF 576, as amended, passed, 23-2. Representatives voting yes: Soderberg,
