Representative Soderberg called the Appropriations Committee meeting to order. Roll was called; quorum present. Minutes from the April 16, 2013 meeting were approved.

Republicans and Democrats went to caucus at 10:39 AM.

The Chair reconvened the meeting at 11:20 AM.

Representative Soderberg requested and received unanimous consent to dissolve the committee into a subcommittee of the whole, and recognized Representative Huseman for opening remarks on [HSB 235](#), An Act relating to and making appropriations to state departments and agencies from the rebuild Iowa infrastructure fund and the technology reinvestment fund, providing for related matters, and including effective date provisions. Questions and discussion followed. Representative Huseman was recognized for closing comments and moved [HSB 235](#). [HSB 235](#) passed out of subcommittee unanimously, short form.

Representative Soderberg requested and received unanimous consent to dissolve the subcommittee of the whole and return to the full committee. The Chair recognized Representative Huseman for opening remarks on [HSB 235](#). With no further opening remarks offered, Representative Soderberg recognized Representative Huseman for opening remarks on amendment 235.1733. Representative Huseman was then recognized for closing comments and moved amendment 235.1733, which passed unanimously, short form.

Representative Soderberg returned committee discussion to [HSB 235](#). Representative Huseman was recognized for opening remarks on [HSB 235](#). With no further opening remarks offered, Representative Soderberg recognized Representative Huseman for closing remarks. Representative Huseman moved [HSB 235](#). [HSB 235](#), as amended, passed 24-0. Representative Running-Marquardt was excused from the meeting and did not vote. [HSB 235](#), as amended, will move to the House floor as a committee bill.

With no further business to come before the committee, Representative Huseman moved to arise.
