Representative Jorgensen (CH) called the meeting to order at 3:04 pm.

The roll was taken.

The minutes from the previous meeting were approved.

The chair turned the chair to the Vice Chair, Representative Stanerson.

Representative Stanerson (CH) recognized Representative Jorgensen for opening remarks on HSB 607 (An act relating to requirements for the enactment of the state percent of growth and the categorical state percent of growth). Representative Jorgensen noted that there was an amendment.

The committee recessed at 5:11pm for party caucuses.

The committee reconvened at 5:21 pm.

The chair recognized Representative Steckman for opening comments on amendment <u>HSB</u> <u>607</u>.2614. After discussion the chair recognized Representative Steckman for closing remarks on amendment <u>HSB 607</u>.2614. Representative Steckman moved amendment <u>HSB 607</u>.2614 for passage. Representative Steckman requested a record vote. The amendment failed on a roll call vote of 10 ayes (Representatives Steckman-RM, Abdul-Samad, Cohoon, Gaines, Hanson,

Mascher, Ruff, Staed, Winckler, and Wood) and 13 nays.
Having disposed of all amendments, the committee was back to consideration of HSB 607.
After discussion, the chair recognized Representative Jorgensen for closing remarks on <u>HSB</u> 607. Representative Jorgensen moved <u>HSB 607</u> for passage. The bill passed with a roll call vote
of 13 ayes and 10 nays (Representatives Steckman-RM, Abdul-Samad, Cohoon, Gaines,
Hanson, Mascher, Ruff, Staed, Winckler, and Wood). Having received a constitutional
majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.
The chair turned the chair back to Representative Jorgensen.
As there was no other business to come before the committee, Representative Fry moved to arise.
The committee adjourned at 6:00 pm.
