The minutes from the previous meeting, February 6, 2014 were approved as previously distributed.

Both parties went to caucus at 4:15 PM.

The committee went to recess at 4:55 PM.

The committee resumed at 5:15 PM.

The Chair, Miller, recognized Rep. Bacon for [HSB 528](#), an act concerning licensure requirements for dietetics as established or approved by the academy of nutrition and dietetics, followed by discussion of the bill. Rep. Bacon moved the bill; a roll call vote was taken. Having received 19 ayes, 0 nays, 2 absent (Rep. Koester, Rep. Murphy), [HSB 528](#) passed out as a committee bill.

The Chair, Miller, recognized Rep. Taylor for [HSB 563](#), an act establishing asset, income, and identity verification requirements for medical assistance applicants and recipients, Rep. Taylor discussed Amendment 2561. Rep. Taylor moved Amendment 2561, a voice vote was taken and the Amendment passed unanimously. Following discussion of [HSB 563](#), Rep. Taylor moved

the bill, a roll call vote was taken. Having received 14 ayes, 5 nays (Rep. Wessel-Kroeschell, Rep. Anderson, Rep. Dawson, Rep. Hunter, Rep. Winckler), 2 absent (Rep. Koester, Rep. Murphy), [HSB 563](#) passed out as a committee bill as amended.

The Chair, Miller, recognized Rep. Hess for [HF 2082](#), an act providing an individual income tax credit for qualified adoption expenses paid or incurred in connection with certain adoptions and including retroactive applicability provisions. Rep. Hess discussed Amendment 2589. Rep. Hess moved Amendment 2589, a voice vote was taken and the Amendment passed unanimously. Following discussion of [HF 2082](#), Rep. Hess moved the bill; a roll call vote was taken. Having received 17 ayes, 2 nays (Rep. Hunter, Rep. Winckler), 2 absent (Rep. Keoster, Rep. Murphy), [HF 2082](#) was passed as amended as a committee bill.

Seeing no further business to come before the committee, Rep. Taylor moved that the meeting adjourn. The Chair adjourned the meeting at 6 PM.
