Chair Cownie recognized Representative Vander Linden for opening remarks on <u>HSB 519</u>; a study bill relating to the regulation of pharmacy benefit managers. The subcommittee report of Reps. Vander Linden, Ourth and Smith was submitted and signed. Rep. Vander Linden gave opening remarks and asked permission to take up amendment 519. 2622. Amendment passed on a voice vote. Rep. Vander Linden gave closing remarks and moved the bill. Chair Cownie moved <u>HSB 519</u>, as amended, as a committee bill on a roll call vote. Motion carried with 23 ayes.

Representative Landon was recognized to take up <u>HSB 569</u>; a study bill relating to matters under the purview of the credit union division of the department of commerce. The subcommittee report of Reps. Landon, Grassley and Kressig was submitted and signed. Rep. Landon gave opening remarks and asked permission to take up amendment 569.2494. Amendment passed on a voice vote. Rep. Landon gave closing remarks moved the bill. Chair Cownie moved <u>HSB 569</u>, as amended, as a committee bill on a roll call vote. Motion carried with 23 ayes.

Representative Grassley was recognized to take up HF 2088; a bill relating to disposition of unclaimed property provisions applicable to gift certificates. The subcommittee report of Reps. Grassley, Dawson and Landon was submitted and signed. Rep. Grassley gave opening remarks, followed by discussion and with closing remarks moved the bill. Chair Cownie moved HF 2088, as a committee bill on a roll call vote. Motion carried with 23 ayes.

With no further business to come before the Committee, Chairman Cownie gave closing remarks and moved to adjourn and Representative Lykam seconded the motion.
