Chairman Byrnes called the meeting to order at 4:03.

The roll was taken and all were present with the exception of Representatives Pettengill and Rogers.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved by the committee.

The committee went to caucus at 4:05 pm. The committee returned to order at 4:25 pm.

Chairman Byrnes recognized Representative Landon for opening comments on [HF 2101](#).

Representative Landon then moved the bill. [HF 2101](#) passed as a committee bill with a vote of 19 ayes, 0 nays and 2 absent.

Chairman Byrnes recognized Vice Chairman Moore for [HSB 597](#). Vice Chairman Moore offered opening comments. Vice Chairman Moore offered opening comments on Amendment 2783, which passed the committee with a voice vote. The committee then returned to [HSB 597](#) and Vice Chairman Moore offered Amendment 2609, which also passed the committee with a voice vote. The committee returned to [HSB 597](#), as amended. Chairman Byrnes moved to ask the DOT to yield to a question, and the committee had no objections. After brief discussion there were no more questions on the bill. Vice Chairman Moore offered closing comments on the bill and moved it for a vote. [HSB 597](#), as amended, passed with a vote of 19 ayes, 0 nays and 2 absent.

Chairman Byrnes recognized Representative Kaufmann for [HSB 548](#). After opening comments, Representative Kaufmann offered Amendment 2722, which passed with a voice vote. After returning to [HSB 548](#) Representative Kaufmann offered Amendment 2792, which also passed with a voice vote. The committee then returned to [HSB 548](#), and Representative Lykam voiced his support for the bill. Representative Kaufmann then offered closing comments and moved the bill. [HSB 548](#) passed with a vote of 19 ayes, 0 nays and 2 absent.

With no further business to come before the committee, Representative Cohoon moved to arise. The meeting was adjourned at 4:42 pm.
