The roll was taken.

The minutes from the previous meeting were approved.

The chair assigned the following bills:

The committee recessed at 3:07 pm for party caucuses.

The committee reconvened at 3:45 pm.

The chair recognized Representative Miller for opening remarks on <u>HSB 555</u> (An act relating to professional development services for elementary teachers to improve students' literacy skills). Representative Miller noted that there were amendments.

The chair recognized Representative Miller of opening remarks on amendment <u>HSB 555</u>.2575. Representative Miller noted that there was an amendment.

The chair recognized Representative Steckman for opening remarks on amendment <u>HSB</u> 555.2626. After discussion, the chair recognized Representative Steckman for closing remarks on amendment <u>HSB 555</u>.2626. Representative Steckman moved her amendment. The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.

The bill as amended passed with a roll call vote of 22 ayes, 0 nays and 1 absent or not voting (Rogers). Having received a constitutional majority, the bill as amended will move to the floor as a committee bill.

The chair recognized Representative Stanerson for opening remarks on <u>HSB 619</u> (An act relating to the duties and authority of the college student aid commission relating to the registration of certain postsecondary schools, to interstate reciprocity agreements, and to

registration fees collected by the commission). After discussion, the chair recognized Representative Stanerson for closing remarks on <u>HSB 619</u>. Representative Stanerson moved the bill. The bill was adopted by a roll call vote of 22 ayes, 0 nays and 1 absent or not voting (Rogers). Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.

The chair recognized Representative Dolecheck for opening remarks on HF 559 (An act relating to school district funding by modifying school budget review committee authority to recommend fiscal reviews and to provide transportation assistance aid, specifying uses of the district management levy, authorizing school districts to levy for transportation costs). Representative Dolecheck noted that there was an amendment.

The chair recognized Representative Dolecheck for opening remarks on amendment <u>HF</u> 559.2670.

The chair deferred on HF 559 until the next committee meeting.
