The chair recognized Representative Hanson for opening remarks on amendment [HF 559.2815](#).

After discussion, the chair recognized Representative Hanson for closing remarks on amendment [HF 559.2815](#). Representative Hanson moved his amendment. The amendment was adopted by a voice vote.

The amendment as amended was adopted by a voice vote.

Having disposed of all amendments, the committee was back to consideration of [HF 559](#) as amended. After discussion, the chair recognized Representative Dolecheck for closing remarks on [HF 559](#) as amended. Representative Dolecheck moved the bill as amended. The bill as amended passed with a roll call vote of 22 ayes, 0 nays and 1 absent or not voting (Rogers).

Having received a constitutional majority, the bill as amended will move to the floor as a committee bill.

The chair recognized Representative Stanerson for opening remarks on [HF 2224](#) (An act requiring reporting on certain educational credits awarded to veterans). After discussion, the chair recognized Representative Stanerson for closing remarks on amendment [HF 2224](#).

Representative Stanerson moved the bill. The bill passed with a roll call vote of 22 ayes, 0 nays and 1 absent or not voting (Rogers). Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor.
