The meeting came to order at 9:35 a.m.

The members went to caucus at 9:35 a.m. and returned at 10:10 a.m.

The minutes of 2/17/14 were approved unanimously.

The Chair recognized Senator Schoenjahn for [SF 2070](#) and its amendment 2853. Senator Schoenjahn made remarks. In short form votes, the amendment 2853 and [SF 2070](#), as amended, passed unanimously. The amended [SF 2070](#) was moved to the calendar as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Senator Boettger for [SF 2124](#) and its amendment 2777. Senator Boettger made remarks. In short form votes, the amendment 2777 and [SF 2124](#), as amended, passed unanimously. The amended [SF 2124](#) was moved to the calendar as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Senator Beall who introduced constituents from his district who had attended the Education Committee meeting.

The Chair recognized Senator Bowman for [SF 2127](#). Senator Bowman made remarks. There were comments from Senators Zaun and Ernst. A record vote, 10-5, passed [SF 2127](#). [SF 2127](#) was moved to the calendar as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Senator Mathis for [SF 2173](#). Senator Mathis made remarks. Senator Sinclair commented. A record vote, 12-3, passed [SF 2173](#). [SF 2173](#) was moved to the calendar as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Senator Wilhelm for [SF 2176](#). Senator Wilhelm made remarks. A short form vote on the bill passed with 14 "ayes". Senator Sinclair was excused. [SF 2176](#) was moved to the calendar as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Senator Bowman for [SF 2219](#). Senator Bowman made remarks. A short form vote passed the bill with 14 "ayes". Senator Sinclair was excused. [SF 2219](#) was moved to the calendar as a committee bill.

Senator Quirmbach yielded the floor to Senator Schoenjahn. He recognized Senator Quirmbach for [SSB 3048](#) and amendment 2838. Senator Quirmbach made remarks. On short form votes, [SSB 3048](#) and amendment 2838 passed on 13 "ayes". Senator Sinclair and Senator Dvorsky were excused. [SSB 3048](#), as amended, was moved to the calendar as a committee bill. Senator Schoenjahn returned the floor to Senator Quirmbach.

The Chair recognized Senator Hogg for [SSB 3149](#) and amendment 2832. Senator Hogg made remarks. On a short form vote, amendment 2832 passed with 14 "ayes". Senator Sinclair was excused. There was discussion of the bill with Senators Johnson, Zaun, and Bowman speaking. A record vote passed [SSB 3149](#), as amended, 9-5. Senator Sinclair was excused.

[SSB 3149](#), as amended, was moved to the calendar as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Senator Mathis for [SSB 3150](#) and amendment 2849. Senator Mathis made remarks. On short form votes, the bill and its amendment each passed with 14 “ayes”. Senator Sinclair was excused. [SSB 3150](#), as amended, was moved to the calendar as a committee bill.

Senator Quirnbach yielded the floor to Senator Schoenjahn. Senator Schoenjahn recognized Senator Quirnbach for [SSB 3155](#) and amendment 2795. Senator Quirnbach made remarks. A short form vote passed amendment 2795 with 14 “ayes”. Senator Sinclair was excused. A record vote passed [SSB 3155](#), as amended, 9-5. Senator Sinclair was again excused. [SSB 3155](#), as amended, was moved to the calendar as a committee bill. The floor was returned to Senator Quirnbach.
