The Chair recognized Senator Boettger for <u>SF 2124</u> and its amendment 2777. Senator Boettger made remarks. In short form votes, the amendment 2777 and <u>SF 2124</u>, as amended, passed unanimously. The amended <u>SF 2124</u> was moved to the calendar as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Senator Beall who introduced constituents from his district who had attended the Education Committee meeting.

The Chair recognized Senator Bowman for <u>SF 2127</u>. Senator Bowman made remarks. There were comments from Senators Zaun and Ernst. A record vote, 10-5, passed <u>SF 2127</u>. <u>SF 2127</u> was moved to the calendar as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Senator Mathis for <u>SF 2173</u>. Senator Mathis made remarks. Senator Sinclair commented. A record vote, 12-3, passed <u>SF 2173</u>. <u>SF 2173</u> was moved to the calendar as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Senator Wilhelm for <u>SF 2176</u>. Senator Wilhelm made remarks. A short form vote on the bill passed with 14 "ayes". Senator Sinclair was excused. <u>SF 2176</u> was moved to the calendar as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Senator Bowman for <u>SF 2219</u>. Senator Bowman made remarks. A short form vote passed the bill with 14 "ayes". Senator Sinclair was excused. <u>SF 2219</u> was moved to the calendar as a committee bill.

Senator Quirmbach yielded the floor to Senator Schoenjahn. He recognized Senator Quirmbach for <u>SSB 3048</u> and amendment 2838. Senator Quirmbach made remarks. On short form votes, <u>SSB 3048</u> and amendment 2838 passed on 13 "ayes". Senator Sinclair and Senator Dvorsky were excused. <u>SSB 3048</u>, as amended, was moved to the calendar as a committee bill. Senator Schoenjahn returned the floor to Senator Quirmbach.

The Chair recognized Senator Hogg for <u>SSB 3149</u> and amendment 2832. Senator Hogg made remarks. On a short form vote, amendment 2832 passed with 14 "ayes". Senator Sinclair was excused. There was discussion of the bill with Senators Johnson, Zaun, and Bowman speaking. A record vote passed <u>SSB 3149</u>, as amended, 9-5. Senator Sinclair was excused.

SSB 3149, as amended, was moved to the calendar as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Senator Mathis for <u>SSB 3150</u> and amendment 2849. Senator Mathis made remarks. On short form votes, the bill and its amendment each passed with 14 "ayes". Senator Sinclair was excused. <u>SSB 3150</u>, as amended, was moved to the calendar as a committee bill.

Senator Quirmbach yielded the floor to Senator Schoenjahn. Senator Schoenjahn recognized Senator Quirmbach for <u>SSB 3155</u> and amendment 2795. Senator Quirmbach made remarks. A short form vote passed amendment 2795 with 14 "ayes". Senator Sinclair was excused. A record vote passed <u>SSB 3155</u>, as amended, 9-5. Senator Sinclair was again excused. <u>SSB 3155</u>, as amended, was moved to the calendar as a committee bill. The floor was returned to Senator Quirmbach.
