Chairman Byrnes called the meeting to order at 1:02 pm. Roll was taken and all were present with the exception of Representative Pettengill. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved by the committee.

The committee went to caucus at 1:04 pm and returned at 1:26 pm.

Chairman Byrnes moved the committee be turned over to Vice Chairman Moore for a subcommittee on House Study Bill 662. With no objections, Vice Chairman Moore offered opening comments on House Study Bill 662. Representative Riding offered support for the bill. Vice Chairman Moore moved for a voice vote, and House Study Bill 662 passed out of subcommittee.

Chairman Byrnes then moved the committee return to consider House Study Bill 662. Vice Chairman Byrnes recognized Vice Chairman Moore for opening comments. With no further discussion, Vice Chairman Moore moved House Study Bill 662. House Study Bill 662 passed with a vote of 18 ayes, 2 nays including Representatives Forbes and Stutsman, 1 absent with Representative Pettengill as a committee bill.

Chairman Byrnes recognized Representative Landon for opening comments on House Study Bill 596. After opening comments, Representative Landon offered Amendment 2569.

Representative Riding offered his support for the amendment. Amendment 2569 passed with a voice vote. The committee returned to House Study Bill 596 as amended. Representatives R. Olson and Meyer opposed the bill, while Representative Riding offered his support.

Representative Landon offered closing comments and moved House Study Bill 596. House Study Bill 596 as amended passed with a vote of 12 ayes, 8 nays including Representatives Lykam, Cohoon, Forbes, Meyer, H. Miller, R. Olson, Stutsman and Wolfe and 1 absent with Representative Pettengill as a committee bill.

Chairman Byrnes then recognized Representative Worthan for opening comments on House Study Bill 547. Representative Worthan then offered Amendment 2831. Representative Cohoon asked for consent to ask the Department of Transportation to yield to a question. With no objections, and after a question on Amendment 2831, Representative Cohoon opposed the amendment. Representative Worthan offered closing comments and moved Amendment 2831. Amendment 2831 passed with a voice vote. The committee returned to House Study Bill 547 as amended. Representative Cohoon rose to oppose the bill. Representative Worthan offered closing comments and moved House Study Bill 547. House Study Bill 547 as amended passed with a vote of 11 ayes, 9 nays including Representatives Lykam, Cohoon, Forbes, Meyer, H. Miller, R. Olson, Riding, Stutsman and Wolfe, and 1 absent with Representative Pettengill as a committee bill.

With no further business to come before the body Representative Rayhons moved to arise. The committee adjourned at 1:52 pm.
