Chair Baudler recognized Representative Fry for opening comments on <u>SF 2121</u>: A bill for an act making changes to the controlled substance schedules, and providing penalties. Representative Fry made opening comments on the bill. After discussion on the bill, Representative Fry made closing comments and moved <u>SF 2121</u>. <u>SF 2121</u> passed 21-0. Having received an affirmative vote of a majority of the committee membership as required to report a bill out of committee, <u>SF 2121</u> moved to the House Floor.

Chair Baudler recognized Representative Shaw for opening comments on SF 2187: A bill for an act requiring the Iowa law enforcement academy to develop training standards for the use of electronic weapons, including stun guns and tasers, by law enforcement agencies throughout the state. Representative Shaw made opening comments on the bill. As there was an amendment to the bill, Chair Baudler recognized Representative Shaw for consideration of Amendment 3121 to SF 2187. After opening comments on the amendment, Chair Baudler recognized members of the committee for discussion on the amendment. After questions and discussion, Representative Shaw moved Amendment 3121. Amendment 3121 passed unanimously with a voice vote. The amendment will move to the floor as a committee amendment. After discussion on the bill, Representative Shaw made closing comments and moved SF 2187 as amended. SF 2187 as amended passed 21-0. Having received an affirmative vote of a majority of the committee membership as required to report a bill out of committee, SF 2187 as amended moved to the House Floor.

As there was no additional business to come before the committee, Representative R. Olson moved to adjourn.
