The Chair recognized Rep. Heaton for opening remarks regarding [SF 2251](#), an Act relating to the state child care assistance program eligibility and application provisions, Rep. Heaton discussed Amendment 3118. Rep. Heaton moved the Amendment short form and passed. With no discussion following Rep. Heaton moved [SF 2251](#), a voice vote was taken and the Amendment passed unanimously. Rep. Heaton moved [SF 2251](#), having received 19 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused (Abdul-Samad, Anderson) [SF 2251](#) passed.

The Chair turned the chair over to Rep. Bacon.

The Chair recognized Rep. Miller for opening remarks regarding [SF 2080](#), an Act relating to exchanging information contained in the Iowa information program for drug prescribing and dispensing. Following discussion of the bill Rep. Miller moved [SF 2080](#), a roll call vote was taken. Having received 19 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused (Abdul-Samad, Anderson) [SF 2080](#) passed.

The chair asked for unanimous consent to discuss [SF 2276](#) and there were no objections.

The Chair recognized Rep. Fry for opening remarks regarding [SF 2276](#), an Act relating to adoption investigation and report requirements. Following discussion of the bill Rep. Fry moved [SF 2276](#), a roll call vote was taken. Having received 19 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused (Abdul-Samad,

Anderson) [SF 2276](#) passed.
