Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Grassley for opening comments on [SF 2119](#), an act relating to campaign finance by requiring electronic filing of certain statements and reports and by raising the minimum dollar amounts that trigger certain regulations. Following discussion, Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Grassley for closing comments on [SF 2119](#). Representative Grassley moved [SF 2119](#). A record roll call was taken and [SF 2119](#) passed (21-2) (Nays: L. Miller, Prichard).

Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Bacon for opening comments on [SF 2283](#), an act providing a procedure for the escheatment of United States savings bonds presumed abandoned. Following discussion, Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Bacon for closing comments on [SF 2283](#). Representative Bacon moved [SF 2283](#).
