The House Local Government Committee was called to order by Chairperson Schultz on 3/12/14 at 1:01pm in Rm 19.

Roll call was taken and Chairperson Schultz declared a quorum present.

The minutes from the previous meeting were approved as previously distributed.

Both parties went to caucus at 1:03pm. Republicans returned from caucus at 1:15pm. Democrats returned from caucus and the meeting was called back to order at 1:25pm.

Representative Windschitl was recognized for opening remarks on <u>SF 366</u>: An Act relating to radon control and making penalties applicable. He noted that there is an amendment. Representative Windschitl was recognized for opening remarks on Amendment 3241. Chair Schultz opened the floor to discussion. Discussion followed. Representative Windschitl was recognized for closing comments on Amendment 3241 and he moved the amendment. A voice vote was taken and Amendment 3241 passed unanimously as a committee amendment.

Chair Schultz opened the floor to discussion of <u>SF 366</u> with a committee amendment. Discussion followed. Representative Windschill was recognized for closing comments on <u>SF 366</u> and moved the bill with committee amendment. A roll call vote was taken and <u>SF 366</u> moves to the floor as a Senate File with a committee amendment, 21 Ayes, 0 Nays and 0 Absent.

Representative Hanusa was recognized for opening remarks on <u>SF 2266</u>: An Act relating to the vehicle registration duties of county treasurers. Chair Schultz opened the floor to discussion of <u>SF 2266</u>. Representative Gaskill asked for unanimous consent to ask a question of an individual not on the committee, Ben Lacey from the Polk County Treasurer's Office. Discussion followed. Representative Thede asked for unanimous consent to question Mr. Lacey from the Polk County Treasurer's Office as well. Discussion followed. Representative Hanusa was recognized for closing remarks on <u>SF 2266</u>. She moved the bill. A roll call vote was taken

and the bill moves to the floor as a Senate File, 21 Ayes, 0 Nays and 0 Absent.

There being no other business to come before the committee, Representative Forbes moved to adjourn.
