Roll call was read and a quorum was present.

As there were no corrections, amendments and/or deletions to the March 11th meeting minutes, they were unanimously approved.

The following bills were assigned:

[HSB 672](#) – Windschitl- Chair, Baltimore & Isenhardt

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Stanerson for opening remarks on [SF 2271](#). An Act relating to the duties and authority of the college student aid commission relating to the registration of certain postsecondary schools, to interstate reciprocity agreements, and to registration fees collected by the commission.

The bill was moved and passed by the vote 23 Aye, 0 Nay and 2 Absent. The bill will move to the house floor as a Senate file.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Landon for opening remarks on [SF 2291](#). An Act providing an exemption from registration fees for certain new completed motor vehicles purchased by an equipment dealer for modification and resale.

The bill was moved and passed by the vote 23 Aye, 0 Nay and 2 Absent. The bill will move to the house floor as a Senate file.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Moore for opening remarks on [SF 2328](#). An Act providing for the reorganization of the Code provisions relating to the Iowa finance authority, revising and eliminating programs, including the beginning farm loan program, providing for existing tax credits, providing for the powers and duties of the authority.

The bill was moved and passed by the vote 23 Aye, 0 Nay and 2 Absent. The bill will move to the house floor as a Senate file.

As there was no additional business to come before the committee Representative Cownie moved to adjourn at 1:27 PM.
