Chairman Sands called the meeting to order at 1:00 PM.

Roll call was read and a quorum was present.

As there were no corrections, amendments and/or deletions to the April 7th meeting minutes, they were unanimously approved.

There were no bills assigned.

Chairman Sands requested unanimous consent to turn the chair over to Representative Landon.

Chairman Landon recognized Representative Sands for opening remarks on [HSB 675](#). An Act relating to Iowa's urban renewal law by establishing restrictions on the use of divided revenues, establishing restrictions on the issuance of certain bonds and indebtedness, modifying the methodology for calculating the amount of divided.

The chair recognized Representative Sands for Amendment 3885. The amendment was moved and passed on short form.

The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote 15 Aye, 10 Nay and 0 Absent. The nay votes were Representatives Oldson, Gaskill, Isenhardt, Kearns, Kelley, Moore, Muhlbauer, Riding, Prichard & Thomas. The bill will move to the house floor as a committee bill as amended.

Chairman Landon returned the chair back to Representative Sands.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Hagenow for opening remarks on [HSB 687](#). An Act relating to the assessment of certain housing rented or leased to low-income individuals and families.

The bill was moved and passed by the vote 20 Aye, 5 Nay and 0 Absent. The nay votes were Representatives Oldson, Gaskill, Isenhart, Kearns & Kelley. The bill will move to the house floor as a committee bill.

As there was no additional business to come before the committee Representative Cownie moved to adjourn at 2:24 PM.
