Chairman Sands called the meeting to order at 1:00 PM.

The committee reconvened at 1:43 PM.

Roll call was read and a quorum was present.

As there were no corrections, amendments and/or deletions to the April 8th meeting minutes, they were unanimously approved.

There were no bills assigned.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Vander Linden for opening remarks on [HF 2406](#). An Act concerning live dog racing at pari-mutuel dog racetracks, simultaneously telecast wagering, establishing fees, and including effective date provisions.

The chair recognized Representative Vander Linden for Amendment 3923. The amendment was moved and passed on short form.

The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote 23 Aye, 1 Nay and 1 Absent. The nay vote was Representative Thomas. The bill will move to the house floor as a committee bill as amended.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Baltimore for opening remarks on [HSB 686](#). An Act creating an individual income tax credit for qualified adoption expenses paid or incurred in connection with certain adoptions and including retroactive applicability provisions.

The bill was moved and passed by the vote 23 Aye, 1 Nay and 1 Absent. The nay vote was Representative Gaskill. The bill will move to the house floor as a committee bill.

As there was no additional business to come before the committee Representative Hagenow moved to adjourn at 1:50 PM.
