Sen. Petersen opened the floor for senators to ask questions of Woodley and Carlson.

Representative Pat Murphy made a motion to request information from all state agencies on any settlements where confidentiality clauses were proposed for merit employees who were asked to leave state employment, from 1999 to present.

Senator Matt McCoy seconded the motion.

Representative Kevin Koester said the House Republicans requested to caucus on the motion.

The committee recessed at 4:21 p.m.

The committee reconvened at 9:17 a.m. on April 15, 2014.

Sen. Petersen said legislators were working with leadership to schedule another Oversight meeting for tomorrow, April 16, 2014, during the 11 a.m. hour.
