Representative Highfill recognized Representative Soderberg for opening remarks on amendment 4070. Following discussion, Representative Soderberg was recognized for closing comments and moved the amendment 4070 on short form. The amendment passed on a voice vote. Representative Highfill returned the committee to [HSB 688](#), as amended. Following discussion, Representative Soderberg was recognized for closing remarks and moved the bill. [HSB 688](#), as amended, passed, 14-11. Representatives voting yes: Soderberg, Highfill, Deyoe, Dolecheck, Drake, Fisher, Gustafson, Heaton, Huseman, Koester, Lofgren, Rogers, Watts, and Worthan.
