Representative Soderberg called the Appropriations Committee to order at 1:16 pm. Minutes from the April 16 were approved as previously read. Both parties immediately went to caucus.

Representative Soderberg reconvened the meeting at 2:26 pm. Roll was called and a quorum was present.

Representative Soderberg requested unanimous consent for the committee to dissolve into a subcommittee as a whole. Representative Soderberg then recognized Representative Dolecheck for opening remarks on <u>SF 2318</u>, an act relating to state and school anti-harassment and antibullying policies, establishing an office of support and analysis for safe schools, establishing a school climate improvement grant program, providing for training on harassment and bullying prevention and response, making appropriations, and including effective date provisions.

Representative Soderberg recognized Representative Dolecheck for opening comments on Amendment 4124. Discussion followed and Representative Dolecheck moved the Amendment and it passed on short form.

The subcommittee of the whole dissolved back into the committee. The Committee reconvened.

Representative Soderberg recognized Representative Dolecheck for opening remarks on <u>SF</u> 2318. Representative Soderberg then recognized Representative Dolecheck for opening comments on Amendment 4124. Discussion followed and Representative Dolecheck moved the Amendment and it passed on short form.

Representative Soderberg recognized Representative Dolecheck for closing comments and he moved <u>SF 2318</u> as amended. The bill was moved and passed by the vote 21 Ayes, 3 Nays (Heddens, T. Taylor and Winckler) and 1 Absent (Drake). The bill will move to the house floor as amended as a Senate File.
