Representative Soderberg called the Appropriations Committee to order at 9:07 pm. Minutes from the April 24 were approved as previously read. Both parties immediately went to caucus. Representative Soderberg reconvened the meeting at 9:56 pm. Roll was called and a quorum was present.

Representative Soderberg relinquished the Chair to Representative Highfill. Representative Highfill requested unanimous consent for the committee to dissolve into a subcommittee as a whole. Representative Highfill then recognized Representative Soderberg for opening remarks on [SF 2363](#), a bill for an act relating to state and local finances by making transfers and appropriations, providing for properly related matters, and including effective date and applicability provisions. Discussion followed. Representative Soderberg gave closing comments and moved the bill and it passed on short form.

The subcommittee of the whole dissolved back into the committee. The Committee reconvened.

Representative Highfill recognized Representative Soderberg for opening remarks on [SF 2363](#). Discussion followed and Representative Soderberg gave closing comments. The bill was moved and passed by the vote of 21 Ayes, 4 Nays (Dunkel, T. Taylor, Thede, Winckler). The bill will move to the house floor as a Senate File.
