Representative Jorgensen (CH) called the committee to order at 4:02 pm.

The Chair recognized Representative Gassman for opening remarks on [HSB 7](#) (An act making a statutory correction to remove an inconsistency regarding the employment of the executive director of the board of education examiners). After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Gassman for closing remarks on [HSB 7](#). Representative Gassman moved [HSB 7](#). The bill passed with a roll call vote of 23 ayes to 0 nays. Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Representative Byrnes for opening remarks on [HSB 12](#) (An act relating to eligibility requirements for the gap tuition assistance program). Representative Byrnes noted that there was an amendment.

The Chair recognized Representative Byrnes for opening remarks on amendment [HSB 12.50](#).

After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Byrnes for closing remarks on his amendment. The amendment was adopted by a voice vote.

After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Byrnes for closing remarks on [HSB 12](#) as amended. Representative Byrnes moved [HSB 12](#) as amended. The bill as amended passed with a roll call vote of 23 ayes to 0 nays. Having received a constitutional majority, the bill as amended will move to the floor as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Representative Dolecheck for opening remarks on [HF 5](#) (An act relating

to shared operational functions for purposes of supplementary weighting and including applicability provisions). After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Dolecheck for closing remarks on [HF 5](#). Representative Dolecheck moved [HF 5](#). The bill passed with a roll call vote of 23 ayes to 0 nays. Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.
