The roll was taken and a quorum was present.

As there were no corrections, amendments and/or deletions to the January 22, 2015, meeting minutes, upon motion by Representative Cohoon, they were unanimously approved.

Steve Michael, Director of the Department of Human Rights, Division of Criminal and Juvenile Justice Planning (CJJP); Laura Roeder-Grubb, Justice Data Warehouse (JDW); and Keith Kreiman, Criminal Justice Information System Integration (CJIS) coordinator; reviewed the responsibilities of their Department and presented their proposed budget.

The mission of the JDW is to provide the Judicial, Legislative and Executive branches of State government and other entities, with improved statistical and decision support pertaining to justice system activities.

Mr. Michael shared examples of how the data is used. The CJJP has also partnered with the University of Iowa, Public Defender, and others on projects relative to criminal and juvenile justice. The JDW is expected to be an ongoing project for the foreseeable future.

The CJIS continues to develop a seamless, real-time, electronic information sharing system for members of the criminal justice community in Iowa. Every county in Iowa receives benefits from the CJIS system. They reviewed the significant accomplishments and the 2015 estimated expenditures. CJIS is expected to be an ongoing project in the foreseeable future. They shared the agencies involved in this program and the "wish list" for continuing expansion. Committee members asked questions regarding this project including the estimated FY 2015 budget of \$2.0 million.

As there was no additional business to come before the Committee, Senator Petersen moved to adjourn at 10:35 a.m.
