Chairman Huseman called the meeting to order at 10:10 a.m.

The roll was taken and a quorum was present. Senator Anderson was also in attendance.

As there were no corrections, amendments and/or deletions to the January 15, 2015, meeting minutes upon motion by Representative Dunkel, they were unanimously approved.

Scott Ayres, Director of Installation Management at the Iowa Army National Guard, Department of Public Defense, presented information for their budget requests. He explained how the Army Guard has changed comparing 1960 information to 2015 information including population and number of armories, etc.

Colonel Ayres reviewed the Mission and support the Iowa Army National Guard provides including 7067 soldiers, 1200 full-time employees, 488 buildings on 98 acres and 44 armories. He also showed the location of Iowa armories by Congressional District and explained the Camp Dodge Joint Maneuver Training Site.

An update was provided on the Fund usage for Armory Projects from Fiscal Year (FY) 2013 through FY 2015. Next discussion was on the FY 2016 Capitals Request including (1) Facility/Armory Major Maintenance account for \$2M; (2) \$2.0M for Statewide Modernization Agenda for the Armories; (3) \$500,000 for Camp Dodge Infrastructure Upgrade.

Colonel Ayres also reviewed the Federal Fund Issues, including the Davenport MILCON \$23 M Federal armory project. Following discussion on the information, He thanked the Committee for the opportunity to make the presentation. Captain Catherine Barton and a Deputy Adjutant General of the Iowa Air National Guard were also present to answer questions.

As there was no additional business to come before the Committee, Representative Maxwell moved to adjourn at 10:45 a.m.
