Representative Jorgensen (CH) called the committee to order at 4:03 pm.

The Roll was taken.

The minutes from the previous meeting were approved.

The committee recessed at 4:05 pm for party caucuses.

The committee reconvened at 4:38 pm.

Representative Jorgensen turned the Chair over to Representative Gassman.

Representative Gassman (CH) recognized Representative Jorgensen for opening remarks on [HSB 95](#) (An act relating to requirements for the enactment of the state percent of growth and the categorical state percent of growth and including effective date and applicability provisions). After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Jorgensen for closing remarks on [HSB 95](#). Representative Jorgensen moved [HSB 95](#). The bill passed with a roll call vote of 13 ayes, 9 nays (Brown-Powers, Cohoon, Gaines, Hanson, Mascher, Ruff, Staed, Steckman, and Winckler) and 1 absent or not voting (Abdul-Samad). Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.

Representative Gassman turned the Chair back to Representative Jorgensen.

Representative Jorgensen (CH) recognized Representative Koester for opening remarks on [HSB 38](#) (An act relating to certain costs under the statewide preschool program for four-year-old children and including effective date and retroactive applicability provisions). After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Koester for closing remarks on [HSB 38](#). Representative Koester moved [HSB 38](#). The bill passed with a roll call vote of 22 ayes, 0 nays and 1 absent or not voting (Abdul-Samad). Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.

As there was no other business to come before the committee, Representative Highfill moved to arise.

The committee adjourned at 4:57 pm.
