As there were no corrections, amendments, and/or deletions to the February 3rd meeting minutes, Chair Vander Linden moved to approve the minutes as distributed.

Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Bacon for opening comments on [HSB 45](#), a study bill relating to licensure of retired volunteer dentists and dental hygienists. Representative Bacon introduced Amendment 64 to [HSB 45](#). After discussion, Representative Bacon moved Amendment 64 and it passed by voice vote. Following discussion, Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Bacon for closing comments on [HSB 45](#), as amended. Representative Bacon moved [HSB 45](#), as amended. A record roll call was taken and [HSB 45](#) passed, as amended (22-1) (Nays: Hunter), and moves to the floor of the house as a committee bill.

Miller for opening comments on [HSB 75](#), a study bill for providing for the licensing of polysomnographic technologists and exceptions thereto, making penalties applicable, and including effective date provisions. Following discussion, Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative L. Miller for closing comments on [HSB 75](#), as amended. Representative L. Miller moved [HSB 75](#), as amended. A record roll call was taken and [HSB 75](#) passed, as amended (20-3) (Nays: Branhagen, Hunter, Watts), and moves to the floor of the house as a committee bill.
