Representative Jorgensen (CH) called the committee to order at 3:04 pm.

The Roll was taken.

The minutes from the previous meeting were approved.

The Chair assigned the following bill:

The committee recessed at 3:05 pm for party caucuses.

The committee reconvened at 3:29 pm.

The Chair recognized Representative Gassman for opening remarks on [HSB 17](#) (An act relating to transitional coaching authorizations issued by the board of educational examiners).

Representative Gassman noted that there were amendments.

The Chair recognized Representative Hanson for opening remarks on amendment [HSB 17.56](#).

After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Hanson for closing remarks on amendment [HSB 17.56](#). Representative Hanson moved the amendment and requested a roll call vote. The amendment was adopted by a roll call vote of 22 ayes to 1 nay (Highfill).

The Chair recognized Representative Hanson for opening remarks on amendment [HSB 17.54](#).

After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Hanson for closing remarks on amendment [HSB 17.54](#). Representative Hanson moved the amendment and requested a roll call vote. The amendment was adopted by a roll call vote of 23 ayes to 0 nays.

Having disposed of all amendments, the committee was back to consideration of [HSB 17](#) as amended. After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Gassman for closing remarks on [HSB 17](#) as amended. Representative Hanson moved [HSB 17](#) as amended. The bill as amended passed with a roll call vote of 20 ayes to 3 nays (Mascher, Staed, and Winckler). Having received a constitutional majority, the bill as amended will move to the floor as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Representative Jones for opening remarks on [HF 97](#) (An act relating to open enrollment of students in online learning programs). Representative Jones noted that there was an amendment.

The Chair recognized Representative Jones for opening remarks on amendment [HF 97.89](#).

The Chair recognized Representative Winckler for opening remarks on amendment [HF 97.89.108](#). After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Winckler for closing remarks on amendment [HF 97.89.108](#). Representative Winckler moved the amendment to the amendment and requested a roll call vote. The amendment to the amendment failed with a roll call vote of 10 ayes (Abdul-Samad, Brown-Powers, Cohoon, Gaines, Hanson, Mascher, Ruff, Staed, Steckman, and Winckler) to 13 nays.

Having disposed of all amendments to the amendment, the Committee was back to consideration of amendment [HF 97.89](#). After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Jones for closing remarks on amendment [HF 97.89](#). Representative Jones moved the amendment. A roll call vote was requested. The amendment was adopted by a roll call vote of 13 ayes to 10 nays (Abdul-Samad, Brown-Powers, Cohoon, Gaines, Hanson, Mascher, Ruff, Staed, Steckman, and Winckler).

Having disposed of all amendments, the committee was back to consideration of [HF 97](#) as amended. After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Jones for closing remarks on [HF 97](#) as amended. Representative Jones moved [HF 97](#) as amended. The bill as amended passed with a roll call vote of 14 ayes to 9 nays (Abdul-Samad, Brown-Powers, Cohoon, Gaines, Hanson, Mascher, Staed, Steckman and Winckler). Having received a constitutional majority, the bill as amended will move to the floor as a committee bill.

As there was no other business to come before the committee, Representative Koester moved to arise.

The committee adjourned at 5:09 pm.
