Landon, Ourth and Rizer was submitted and signed. Rep. Landon gave opening remarks and asked permission to take up amendment 119.189. Amendment passed on a voice vote. Discussion followed and Rep. Landon gave closing remarks and moved the bill. Chair Cownie moved <u>HSB 119</u>, as amended as a committee bill on a roll call vote. Motion carried with 23 ayes.
